

## **Accredited Paralegal Diploma Program**

Herzing College Toronto is proud to announce that on December 15, 2009 our Paralegal diploma program was accredited by the Law Society of Upper Canada (LSUC).

Graduates of the accredited Paralegal program will be eligible to apply to write the Paralegal Licensing Examination through LSUC, that must be completed in order to qualify to practice as a duly qualified licensed Paralegal in Ontario.

This is a one year program and includes an internship of 120 hours which is a requirement to write the licensing exam.

The Paralegal program provides both theory and practical skills covering all areas where Paralegals are permitted to practice such as small claims court, advocacy, highway traffic, tribunals and landlord and tenant. Graduates will work in law firms, Government offices, corporate legal departments and many will chose to become self-employed.

As well as Paralegal accreditation, Herzing College Toronto holds institutional accreditation, granted by the Canadian Education and Training Accreditation Commission (CETAC), as further assurance of quality and standards.
